

*Since the beginning of Geneva II Peace conference:
Government Forces killed 2247 civilians
almost half of them from Aleppo*

The report only contains the Death toll of civilians since 22/1/2014 to 14/2/2014

There wasn't any differentiation in Syrian death toll before or after Geneva II, the daily killing frequency was continuing and even increased over the average as in the last two days, where more than 100 civilians killed.

SNHR is an independent human rights organization that document Syrian conflict's civilian victims caused by government forces or opposition troops.

Government forces systematically and routinely continue shelling barrel bombs on Aleppo and Daraa governorate, without stopping artillery and missile shelling, and even used internationally banned cluster bombs in Halfaya of Hama countryside without any clear condemnation by the international community represented in the Arab and international representative Mr. Lakhdar Brahimi, who still consider them as partners in the peace process to this moment.

Why they at least stop killing civilians?

SNHR's team documents the kill of at least **2247 civilians** by name, picture or video, Since the beginning of the peace talks until the end of the second round of talks, among the victims there were at least **382 children, 235 women, and 217 victims have been tortured to death**, the proportion of women and children is 27% of the victims, which is a very clear indication of the deliberate targeting of civilians.

The international community represented by the United Nations should take all necessary requirements to protect civilians in Syria, not just holding conferences and launching denunciations and slogans without any real binding procedures against violators of international law's sanctity, and make from them lesson not an ideal for the other criminals.
