



## 129 Individuals Killed and Not Less than 896 Documented since the beginning of the Cessation of Hostilities Agreement

### I. Introduction

This report depicts the new breaches of the ceasefire agreement where daily reports about this occasion were issued since it started and up to 14 March 2016.

In this report we update the information about the ceasefire agreement since 14 up to 25 March 2016, when the negotiations stopped. Different Syrian governorates, especially regions under the control of armed opposition, witnessed a significant decline in the shelling and killing percentages since March 2011. However, it is worth noting that regions under the government control or Kurdish Self Management Forces are not subjected to government shelling which is considered responsible for killing more than 60% of the victims in addition to destroying houses and displacing its residents.

We noticed that the residents sent their children back to schools again and great numbers of patients went to hospitals to get treated since the shelling decrease as hospitals and schools were continuously shelled. Additionally, infrastructure rehabilitation was conducted since the shelling has decreased.

However, the Syrian regime continued to breach the ceasefire in several ways as it is one of the most affected parties regarding this agreement and unpublicized violations have been continuous like torturing detainees.






The Syrian regime continued to commit massacres against civilians in regions that are under ISIL's control. Government forces committed two massacres in Al Raqqa governorate on 18 and 19 March 2016 since ISIL-controlled regions are not included in the ceasefire agreement.

In SNHR, we aspire that the cessation of hostilities shall transform into an entire ceasefire all over Syria with no exceptions. This action should be followed by a political process that does justice to all victims, holds all perpetrators accountable for their crimes, including the Syrian regime that violated the rights of Syrian people in several ways.

## II. Executive Summary:

Since 27 February 2016, when the ceasefire agreement started, not less than 896 breaches were committed until 25 March 2016 including military operations, arrests, and obstruction of humanitarian aid.





## **1. Military Operations:**

## **2. Arrests:**

There was no progress regarding the release of detainees, disclosing their whereabouts or even allowing their families to visit them. SNHR documented the arrest of 381 individuals, detailed as follows according to the main conflict parties:

**3. Obstructing Humanitarian Aid:** Several convoys of humanitarian aid entered different besieged regions, including Al Houla region in Homs suburbs. The relief aid was delayed which caused mass starvation for the regions' residents. However, these cities are still under siege. Three breaches regarding this issue were documented; 2 in Damascus suburbs and 1 in Homs.

### III. Reports of the New Incidents:

During the first round of the negotiations (since 15 up to 25 March 2016) not less than 292 breaches were documented which included military operations or arrests.

#### 1. Military operations:



## 1. Military Operations:

### A. Government Forces:

#### Damascus suburbs:

**Daraya City:** on 16 March 2016: we recorded 4 breaches by government forces. The city is under the control of armed opposition and is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

Details of the four breaches:

At 11:35 am, 8:44 pm, 5:40 pm, and 11:11 pm, government forces used its machine guns and launched two mortars on the southern and northern fronts in the city; which killed an armed opposition member and injured 2 others.

**Daraya City:** on 18 March 2016: we recorded two breaches by government forces.

Details of the two breaches:

At 3:25 pm, and 6:20 pm, first government forces used its machine guns to target Daraya city. Then a government sniper killed an armed opposition member during his night watch in the southern front in Daraya city.

**Jisreen town:** on 18 March 2016: the town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

Government warplanes launched several rockets on the agricultural lands in Jisreen town in eastern Ghouta.

**Khan Al Sheeh town:** 19 March 2016: we recorded 5 breaches by government forces. The town is under the joint control of armed opposition and Al Nusra front.

1st: government helicopters dropped 4 barrel bombs on Al Qusour region southern of Khan Al Sheeh camp.

2nd: 40 minutes later government helicopters dropped 4 more barrel bombs on Al Abaseyi farms in the eastern side of Khan Al Sheeh.

3rd: government helicopters dropped 8 barrel bombs on Al Qusour region southern of Khan Al Sheeh camp.

4th: government artillery in Tallat Al Kabouseyi launched several missiles on Al Abaseyi farms in Khan Al Sheeh.

5th: at 3:30 pm government artillery forces shelled Nestle Street that is adjacent to [Khan Al Sheeh camp](#) which killed a child and injured 4 others. It is worth mentioning that this street is the only open road for civilians.

**Deir Assafeer Town – Eastern Ghouta:** 19 March 2016: the town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

At 3 pm government artillery forces launched 8 missiles on the residential neighborhoods in Deir Assafeer town which damaged some houses.

**Daraya City:** 19 March 2016: we recorded two breaches by government forces.

Details of the two breaches: on 9:50 pm and 10:20 pm government forces used its machine guns on the northern front in Daraya city.

**Daraya City:** 20 March 2016: at 2am government forces used its machine guns against the northern front in Daraya city.

**Daraya City:** 21 March 2016: we recorded three breaches by government forces.

Details:

1st and 2nd: At 7:45 pm government forces launched 6 mortar missiles on two different locations in the northern front in Daraya city.

3rd: at 9:05 pm government forces launched its machine guns on the northern front again in Daraya city.

**Kafar Batna town:** 22 March 2016: the city is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front. Governemnt artillery launched a mortar missile that fell on the market in Kafar Batna town in eastern Ghouta.

**Daraya City:** 23 March 2016: at 4:15 pm government artillery forces launched a mortar missile on the southern region in the city.

**Al Zabadani Region:** government warplanes launched several rockets on the eastern mountain in Al Zabadani region in Damascus suburbs. The mountain is considered as a station for armed opposition. The region is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**Khan Al Sheeh town:** on 23 March 2016: the town is under the joint control of armed opposition and Al Nusra front.

Since 1 and until 2pm government helicopters dropped 12 barrel bombs on Al Qusour farms in the eastern side of Khan Al Sheeh. The town is under the joint control of armed opposition and Al Nusra front. It is free of any ISIL presence.

**Daraya City:** 24 March 2016: the city is under the control of armed opposition forces and free of Al Nusra front or ISIL's presence.





### **Idlib Governorate:**

- **Al Tamena' Town:** 16 March 2016: the region is under the control of armed opposition. Al Nusra front is present southern of the town on Ma'an front. Government artillery launched 4 missiles on Ma'an town in Idlib southern suburbs.
  
- **Badama town:** 17 March 2016: Government warplanes launched several rockets on Badama town. The town is not controlled by any military group.
  
- **Al Tamena' town:** 19 March 2016: we recorded two breaches by government forces. The town is under the control of armed opposition. Al Nusra front is present southern of the town on Ma'an front. At 10:30 pm government artillery launched several artillery missiles on the town's center and on the agricultural lands on the town's periphery.
  
- **Al Tamena' Town:** 20 March 2016: at 2:30 am government artillery forces launched several missiles on the agricultural lands on the town's periphery. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL's presence. Al Nusra front is present in southern region in the city.
  
- **Al Skeek town:** 20 March 2016: government warplanes launched several rockets on the middle of Skeek town. The town is not controlled by any military faction, except for the southern region which is controlled by one of the armed opposition groups.
  
- **Al Najeya town:** 21 March 2016: at 9:45 am government helicopters dropped 6 barrel bombs on Al Najeya town in Jisr Al Shoughour. The town is under the joint control of armed opposition and Al Nusra front.
  
- **Ma'arand town:** 21 March 2016: at 10 am government warplanes dropped two barrel bombs on the periphery of Ma'arand town. The town is under the joint control of armed opposition and Al Nusra front.
  
- **Badama town:** 21 March 2016: at 3 pm government artillery forces launched several rockets on Badama town in Jisr Al Shoughour in Idlib. The town is not controlled by any military faction.
  
- **Khan Shaykhoun City:** 22 March 2016: government warplanes launched a rocket on the northern neighborhood in Khan Shakoun city which injured 3 individuals. The city is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.





- **Al Tamaneaa' town:** 23 March 2016: the region is under the control of armed opposition only. Al Nusra front is present southern of the town on Ma'an front. Government warplanes launched a rocket on the agricultural lands in Al Tamaneaa' town in southern Idlib suburbs.

- **Al Tamaneaa' town:** 24 March 2016: government warplanes launched a rocket on the agricultural lands in Al Tamaneaa' town in southern Idlib suburbs.

- **Al Skeek town:** 25 March 2016: at 10:30 pm, government launched several rockets on agricultural lands in Al Skeek town. The town is almost depopulated and is not controlled by any military factions except the southern region which is controlled by an armed opposition group.

- **Areeha town:** 25 March 2016: government warplanes launched several rockets on Areeha city which killed 3 individuals. The town is not controlled by any military faction.

#### **Daraa Governorate:**

- **Kafr Nasej town:** 16 March 2016: At 1:30 pm, government forces shelled an armed opposition vehicle in Kafr Nasej town in Daraa which killed two armed opposition members, injured 3 others and destroyed the car. The town is under the control of armed opposition.

- **Ebtee' town:** 16 March 2016: At 1:40 pm, a government sniper  
At 1:40 pm, a government sniper killed a Sheppard in Ebtee' town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

- **Tal Antar:** 16 March 2016: govenremtn artillery forces shelled the town with several artillery rockets. The town is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

- **Kafr Nasej town:** 17 March 2016: government artillery launched several missiles on civilian houses in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

- **Al Teeha town:** 17 March 2016: at 7:50 pm government forces used its machine guns against civilian houses in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.





- **Daraa Al Balad neighborhood:** 17 March 2016: at 9:25pm, government forces used machine guns against civilian houses in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

- **Daraa Al Balad neighborhood:** 18 March 2016: at 12:30 pm, government forces used machine guns against civilian houses in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

- **Al Yadouda Town:** 18 March 2016: at 10 pm government forces used heavy machine guns on a front that belonged to an armed opposition group which injured a member of its own. The town is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

- **Al Harra city:** 22 March 2016: government artillery forces launched an artillery missile on Al Harra city. The town is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

- **Al Yadouda Town:** 23 March 2016: at 9 pm government forces used heavy machine guns on civilian houses. The town is under the control of armed opposition and it is free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

#### **Al Qunaitera Governorate:**

- **Masahara town:** 17 March 2016

At 1:30 pm government artillery forces launched 3 missiles on Masahara town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Masahara town:** 22 March 2016:

At 12:15 pm government artillery forces launched 3 missiles on a civilian region in Masahara town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

#### **Homs Governorate:**

- **Talbisa City:** 17 March 2016:

Government forces committed 3 breaches in Talbisa city. The city is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

1st breach: government forces used machine guns against the western farms in Talbisa city.

2nd breach: government forces launched its artillery missiles on the western farms in Talbisa city





3rd breach: at 11:42 pm, government tanks launched two missiles on the residential neighborhoods in Talbisa city.

**- Um Sharhouh Town: 17 March 2016:**

We recorded two breaches. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front.

1st breach: government forces used machine guns against the vicinity of Um Sharhouh town in Homs.

2nd breach: government artillery forces launched several mortar missiles on an armed opposition front in the city.

**- Teir Ma'ala town: 18 March 2016:**

A government tank launched several missiles on an armed opposition front in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Un Sharhouh town: 19 March 2016:**

The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence. At 12 pm, government forces launched 5 missiles on an armed opposition front in Um Sharhouh town.

**- Al Rastan city: 19 March 2016:**

We recorded two breaches by government forces. The city is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

Details:

1st: at 7 pm, government artillery forces launched a missile on residential region in Al Rastan city.

2nd: at 7 pm, government forces used its machine guns on civilian houses in the middle of Al Rastan city.

**- Al Ghagar town: 19 March 2016:**

At 7:50 pm government forces targeted an armed opposition front in Al Ghagar town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Um Sharhouh town: 20 March 2016:**

At 9 pm, government forces launched two artillery missiles on an armed opposition front in the town.





- **Talbisa city:** 20 March 2016:

At 7 pm, government forces launched several artillery missiles and used its machine guns against the agricultural lands in the city.

- **Um Sharhouh town:** 23 March 2016: we recorded two breaches:

1st: at 11 pm, government forces used its machine guns on the vicinity of Um Sharhouh town.

2nd: 11:05 pm, government forces launched an artillery missile on an armed opposition front.

- **Al Gahar town:** 23 March 2016: at 11 pm:

Government forces used its machine guns to target an armed opposition front in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Teir Ma'ale town:** 23 March 2016: Government forces committed two breaches:

a. Government forces launched 3 mortar missiles on the residential neighborhoods.

b. Government artillery forces launched a missile on an armed opposition front.

**Lattakia Governorate:**

- **Al Yamda town:** 17 March 2016:

At 11:30 pm, government rocket launchers launched three rockets on a civilian region in Al Yamda town in the Turkmen mountain. As a result, a civilian and a mosque were damaged. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Al Tefaheya town:** 17 March 2016:

Government artillery forces launched several artillery missiles on the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Al Yamda – Sallour Road:** 17 March 2016:

Government artillery forces launched several artillery missiles on the road between Yamda and Sallour towns. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Shahroura town:** 18 March 2016:

Government artillery forces launched missiles on Al Shahroura town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.





- **Killiz town:** 19 March 2016:

Government forces committed 5 breaches. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence. Government forces launched several artillery missiles on an armed opposition front in Killiz town in the Turkmen Mountain several times during the day. At the same time, it tried to invade the town and as a result, armed opposition responded to the firing source.

- **Al Sarraf town:** 19 March 2016:

Government forces committed 5 breaches. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence. Government forces launched several artillery missiles on an armed opposition front in Al Sarraf town in the Turkmen Mountain. At the same time, it tried to invade the town and as a result, armed opposition responded to the firing source.

- **Al Haddada town:** 20 March 2016: we recorded two breaches.

The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence. Government rocket launchers launched several rockets on an armed opposition front twice.

- **Al Tefaheya town:** 20 March 2016: we recorded 4 breaches.

The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence. Government rocket launchers launched several rockets on an armed opposition front four times during the day.

- **Al Tefaheya town:** 21 March 2016:

Government rocket launchers launched several rockets on an armed opposition front. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Al Bernas town:** 21 March 2016:

Government rocket launchers launched several rockets on an armed opposition front. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Talat Rashou:** 21 March 2016:

Government forces used its machine guns against an armed opposition front in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.





- **Shahroura town:** 21 March 2016:

Government forces committed 4 breaches. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence. Government artillery forces launched several missiles on an armed opposition front several times during the day.

- **Sallour town:** 21 March 2016: we recorded 4 breaches.

The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence. Government artillery forces launched several missiles on an armed opposition front several times during the day.

- **Al Tefaheyi town:** 22 March 2016:

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Haddada town:** 22 March 2016:

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on an armed opposition front in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Al Saraf town:** 22 March 2016:

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on an armed opposition front in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Killiz town:** 22 March 2016:

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on an armed opposition front in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Al Yamda town:** 22 March 2016:

Government forces committed 2 breaches. Government artillery forces launched several artillery missiles on civilian regions in the town two times. The shelling damaged the local council's building in the city and damaged 3 civil defense vehicles.

Government warplanes launched several rockets on the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.





## **Hama Governorate:**

Government forces used its machine guns against a civilian region in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

### **- Al Sharee'a town: 15 March 2016:**

Government forces used its machine guns against a civilian region in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

### **- Al Jurneyi town: 15 March 2016:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on a civilian region in Al Jurneyi town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

### **- Kantara town: 15 March 2016:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on a civilian region in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

### **- Hanefa town: 15 March 2016:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on a civilian region in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

### **- Taksees town: 16 March 2016:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on a civilian region in the town thus injuring 4 civilians from one family. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

### **- Al Kantara town:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on a civilian region in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

### **- Hanefa town: 16 March 2016:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on a civilian region in the town.





The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Al Qantara town: 17 March 2016:**

Government helicopters dropped 4 barrel bombs on a residential region in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Kafar Nabouda town: 18 March 2016:**

Government warplanes launched 3 rockets on the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Al Madeeq Citadel Region: 19 March 2016:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on the region. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Al Damina town: 19 March 2016:**

Government warplanes launched several rockets on a civilian region in the town which injured 4 individuals. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Al Sayyad town: 20 March 2016:**

Government warplanes launched several rockets on the agricultural lands in the town which injured 4 individuals. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Kafar Nabouda town: 20 March 2016:**

Government warplanes launched three rockets on the agricultural lands on the town. Also, government rocket launchers launched several rockets on the agricultural lands as well. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

**- Kafr Zeita city: 21 March 2016:**

- **Al Tulul Al Humur town:** 22 March 2016:

Government forces launched several artillery missiles on a town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Kafr Nabouda town:** 22 March 2016:

Government warplanes launched 3 rockets on the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Al Madeeq Citadel region:** 22 March 2016:

Government forces launched several artillery missiles on a civilian region in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence

- **Kafr Nabouda town:** 23 March 2016:

Government warplanes launched 5 rockets on an armed opposition front in the town. A video that depicts the shelling: <https://youtu.be/pNBF7Bx5XqM>

- **Al Dumneyi town:** 23 March 2016:

Government helicopters dropped two barrel bombs on a civilian region in the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Shahshabo Mountain:** 23 March 2016:

Government rocket launchers shelled a civilian region in the region. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence.

- **Kafr Zeita City:** 24 March 2016:

Government warplanes launched two rockets on an armed opposition front in the city. The city is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence





**- Al Satheyat town: 24 March 2016:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on a residential region the town. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence

**Aleppo Governorate:**

**- Al Najar town: 17 March 2016:**

Government helicopters dropped several barrel bombs on the town in southern Aleppo suburbs which killed a woman and a child. The shelling also injured several others. The town is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence

**- Al Ferdos neighborhood: 22 March 2016:**

Government artillery forces launched several missiles on the neighborhood where it targeted Al Hajj roundabout which killed an individual and injured another. The neighborhood is under the control of armed opposition and free of any ISIL or Al Nusra front presence

**B. Armed Opposition Groups:**

**Aleppo Governorate:**

**- Al Sheikh Maksoud neighborhood: 19 March 2016:** the targeted region is controlled by the Kurdish Self Management forces:

Armed opposition groups in Al Halak neighborhood shelled Al Zuhour Street in Al Sheikh Maksoud with local made missiles which killed 4 individuals including 3 children and injured 7 others.

**- Al Midan Neighborhood: 18 March 2016:**

The neighborhood is under the control of government forces:

Armed opposition groups in Bustan Al Basha neighborhood launched a local made missile on Bijou Square in Al Midan neighborhood in Aleppo which killed a woman and injured others.

**- Al Zahraa Neighborhood: 17 March 2016:**

The neighborhood is under the control of government forces: armed opposition groups in Al Rashedeen neighborhood launched several local made missiles on Al Shami Street in Al Zahraa neighborhood which killed 3 individuals including 2 children and injured 2 others. One of the houses was damaged.





- **Al Zahraa Neighborhood:** 23 March 2016:

The neighborhood is under the control of government forces: armed opposition groups in Al Rashedeen neighborhood launched several local made missiles on the neighborhood which damaged a mosque. Shelling aftermath:

#### IV. Recommendations:

- We ask the joint American and Russian committee to investigate these incidents, announce its results to the Syrian people and prevent it from happening again.
- We demand the international community to correlate the ceasefire with political efforts that would pave the way towards a transitional stage that would result in a democratic regime, which will end the suffering of the Syrian people.

If breaches are still being committed, then this fragile ceasefire may fail at any moment. Since USA is a major advocate for this agreement, then it should persuade the Russian government to cease its airstrikes and pressure its ally the Syrian government to do so.
