



The arrest of the engineer Su'ad Al Taieb

A local sources reported to SNHR that the Syrian authorities had arrested the activist Su'ad Al Taieb for a second time on Friday 19/7/2013 at Al-Qtiefa checkpoint located in northeastern Damascus. Mrs. Su'ad Al Taieb works in the relief field and she doesn't have any other activities.

The Syrian authorities through its repressive practices try to eradicate the culture of civil resistance, target the culture of humanitarian work with all its forms and deter the spirit of solidarity among Syrian people.

Damascus by a security patrol affiliated to Al Khateeb branch of the State Security and was released on 2/9/2012.

SNHR condemns the arrest of Mrs. Su'ad Al Taieb and the arrest of all humanitarian workers by government forces as it is a violation of the International Law which binds the government to facilitate and allow passage of humanitarian relief without any restrictions and insure the necessary freedom of movement for humanitarian workers. SNHR demands the immediate release of the detainee Su'ad and all detainees and calls on the concerned international organizations to put serious pressure on the Syrian government to cease the violations against humanitarian work.
