

Statement on filing a complaint on an extrajudicial killing case for the United Nations' Special Rapporteur

The Syrian Network for Human Rights (SNHR), founded in June 2011, is a non-governmental, independent group that is considered a primary source for the OHCHR on all death toll-related analyses in Syria.

The citizen Awwad al Khalaf al Jdie'

killed by Syrian regime forces

The Syrian Network for Human Rights informed the United Nations Special Rapporteur on the extrajudicial killing on the case of the citizen Awwad al Khalaf al Jdie', from Deir Ez-Zour governorate, Buqrus Foqani village, born in 1942, and died as fixed-wing Syrian regime warplanes fired missiles on Buqrus Foqani village, affiliated to al Mayadeen city in the eastern suburbs of Deir Ez-Zour governorate and controlled by ISIS at the time of the incident, on September 30, 2017.

The Syrian Authorities didn't admit to killing the citizen, and his family couldn't submit a complaint out of fear of security pursuit.

SNHR confirmed its fear of the killing of civilians from the year 2011, and the victims' numbers are continuously rising.
